Directions: Take Route 2 East/ West to exit 31 A/B. Follow route 12 North 3.2 miles to Putnam Street in Fitchburg. Turn right over the Putnam St. bridge. (Sign in and number pick-up is immediately on your left.) Turn right again onto Boulder Drive. On street parking is available throughout Fitchburg.

The Course: Workers' Credit Union Downtown Criterium

Start / Finish at Fitchburg City Hall. A .9 mile, flat, fast, three corner criterium.

Riders must pick up their numbers between 9:30AM - 11:00AM on Sunday July 5th at the Backstretch Welcome Center, located on Boulder Drive in Fitchburg.

Unlicensed riders must purchase a one-day USCF license for \$10.00 at registration. One-day licensees are only permitted to race in the Category 5 event only.

Jerseys must have at least short sleeves that extend over shoulders.

No triathlon / aero bars

Race numbers must be worn on the left side of the body.
